# VONLAYS : BLENDING TRADITION AND INNOVATION

VONLAY IS A BLEND OF AN ONLAY WITH AN EXTENDED BUCCAL VENEER SURFACE FOR USE IN PREMOLAR REGION, WHERE THERE IS SUFFICIENT ENAMEL PRESENT TO BOND. THIS RESTORATIVE OPTION REQUIRES A MUCH LESS INVASIVE PREPARATION THAN A FULL COVERAGE CROWN BUT PROVIDES THE SAME STRUCTURAL BENEFITS.

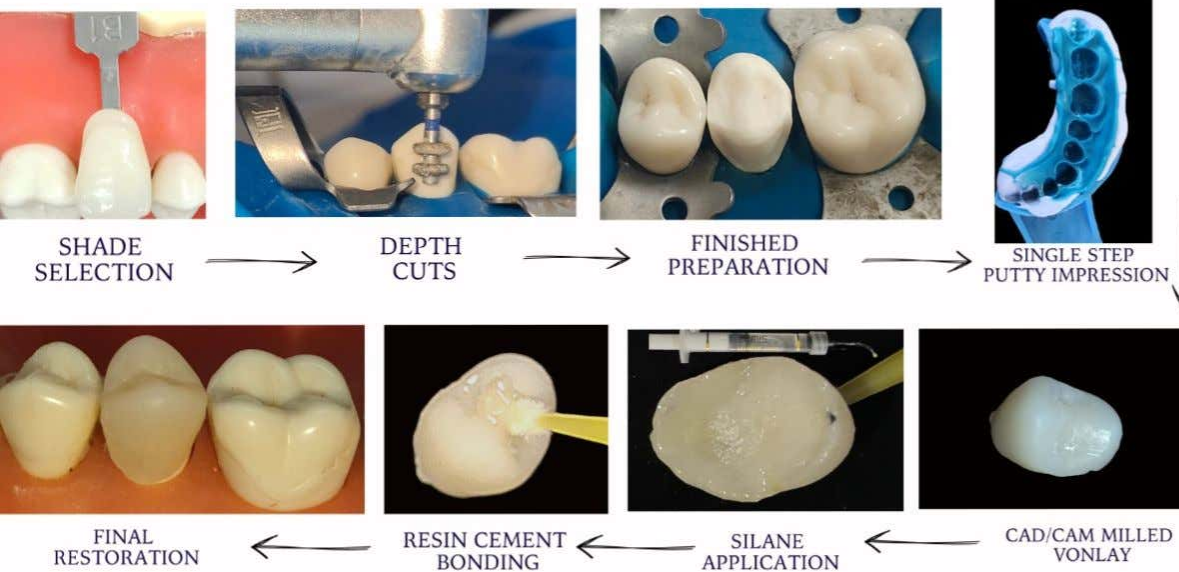
## AIM:

The purpose of the present poster is to present a clinical case, in which an esthetic and conservative posterior Vonlay is used to restore a multi-rooted teeth.

## INDICATIONS:

1. Multi-surface erosions
2. Structural , color and texture defects (fluorosis)
3. tooth wear and cervical lesions
4. Full mouth rehabilitation for aesthetic reasons

- MINIMALLY INVASIVE

- PRESERVATION OF PROXIMAL CONTACTS AND MARGINAL INTEGRITY.

## DISADVANTAGES:

- LESSER DURABILITY
- TECHNIQUE SENSITIVE
- LESS ECONOMICAL AS COMPARED TO FULL COVERAGE CROWNS.

## CONCLUSION:

Vonlays represents a very conservative treatment alternative as it allows preservation of tooth structure, it is compatible with minimally invasive dentistry, and it is adequate for the concept of bio integration.
