









Relative Dentin

medium abrasive. 70-100
high abrasive. 100-150
highly abrasive 150-250

## Is Your Toothpaste Healing or Hurting Your Teeth?

Toothpaste most widely used tool for maintaining oral hygiene but wrongly selected can be a major attributor to dental abrasion.





Factors contributing to toothbrush abrasion :

- 1. RDA abrasivity, > 250
- 2. Brushing duration, > 5 min
- 3. Bristle stiffness, hard
- Force of brushing,>3N
- 5. Horizontal brushing

## **Toothpaste Abrasion**





American National
Standard Institute and ADA
consider toothpaste with
RDA below 250 to be safe
and effective for a life time
use.



Toothpaste should not contain more than 40% of abrasive particle.

Toothbrush traps the abrasive particle and keep them in contact with the tooth structure.
Brushing using only water is RDA value of 4
